**Laid back** – Relaxed or calm

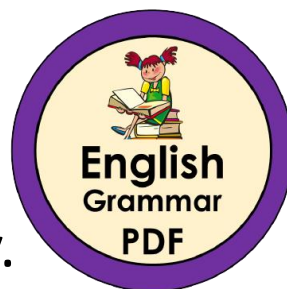
**Lame** – The opposite of cool or fantastic

**Pass the buck:** transfer responsibility

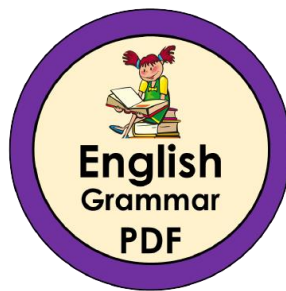
