Put the adverbs in the right places: (manner-place-time)

- We shall fly (**for hours, over the sea, very high**).
- Salem teaches (**in two schools, quite well, for a long time**).
- The carpenter had made the table (**by evening, in six hours, with teak wood**).

- All those students visit (**hill stations, in summer, eagerly**).
