## To & For

- The word "To" can be used as infinitive maker or as a preposition.
- To is used for comparing, giving, direction, distance, destination and motivations.

She prefers reading to eating.

- The "for" is a preposition that is followed by a gerund or a noun.
- For is used for agreeing, explaining function, schedule benefits and period of time etc.

Ali was waiting for her girlfriend.
