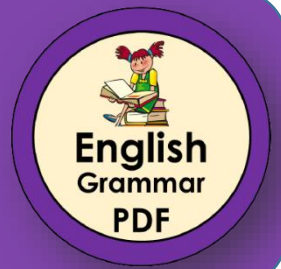


Catch

Catch means: to intercept and hold (something which has been thrown, propelled, or dropped).

Catch	Caught	Caught
