

Until, During, & Like

Until

Meaning of until is 'up to'. It is subordination conjunction. It is used to connect action and an event to a point up to a specific time.

During

During represent the period of time. It is a preposition and we use it to talk about some event or situation that happens at a certain point within the period of time.

Like

Like is used to relate someone or something to other. It is a preposition and used to say how someone looks like.

Examples

- We have to wait here **until** the bus came.
- You can play **until** you eat breakfast.
- We have to wait **until** the winter holidays begin.
- Sara was the headmaster **until** she retires in 2020.
- My mom will stay here **until** 6'Clock.
- We are planning to play **until** 12'clock.
- We will play hockey **during** our stay in Pakistan.
- She got injured **during** the last cricket match.
- We will decide about this **during** the break.
- There are 3 month holidays **during** summer.
- **During** the war, we need supplies.
- Students are not allowed to bring mobile **during** exams.
- His pant is **like** mine.
- Hamza looks **like** his father.
- He can run very fast **like** a rabbit.
- I was planning to fly **like** a bird.
- That sounds **like** a dirt bike.
- Your hand smells **like** lemons.
